SOLO EXHIBITION PROPOSAL - Submit 10-20 images with a corresponding list of image titles on CD's or high quality 8.5" X11" PRINTS. Include resume and artist statement. Please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your CD's/prints return postage.

CURATORIAL PROPOSAL - Submit a brief description of your proposal. Include examples of artwork, curator's & artists' resumes and artist statements if available.

Send up to 10 images per show -low resolution jpegs preferred (4" max dimension, 72 dpi), slides or high quality 8.5" X11" PRINTS of each image. Label CD with artists' name, email and phone number. Label slides and printouts clearly with artist's name, title of work, dimensions (framed size), medium, date of artwork and indicate TOP of slides. Include a SUBMISSION LIST including the artist's name, numbered list of titles, dimensions (framed size), medium and date of artwork.

Promotional Photos: Submit up to three high quality photos or high resolution digital images (8" max dimension, 300 dpi) for press/promotional use. This is optional but likely to land your work on our website, our eblast announcement or in the print media!

Please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for return.

No entry fee. GCCA membership is required to exhibit. Membership forms are available at www.greenearts.org.

Accepted work must be ready to display. Two-dimensional artwork must be suitably framed and ready for hanging. HANGING WIRE required. Please check with us on availability of pedestals for three-dimensional works. Any special hanging or displaying arrangements must be made in advance with the Visual Arts Director.

Commission: 70% artists and 30% GCCA.
